



Wildflower Project Rabbit Proof Fencing



The Next Steps In Improving Wildflower Growth on Hell Wath.

In the next few weeks volunteers will be installing fencing in Areas D and A on the map below. Updates will be posted on the website (use QR code above)

The fencing in D will be temporary (removed at the end of the season) and the fencing in A will stay for a longer period of time.

This work is a direct result of the advice FOHW has received from Plantlife, aimed at improving the wildflower and grassland habitats on Hell Wath and has the agreement of North Yorkshire Council.

Map 1: Approximate boundary of Hell Wath Greenspace (red outline), Hell Wath LNR (blue outline) and parcels A-D, 8a & 8b (orange outlines).

This fencing will allow areas of grassland to grow without rabbit grazing so that wildflowers can be encouraged to flower and reseed.

No footpaths (statutory or unofficial) will be blocked by the fencing and you will be able to see close up what flowers appear.
