## **Skill & Commitment Needed**

Above all, FOHW needs local people with a love for Hell Wath with the drive and enthusiasm to work with the Trustees to take the charity forward.

Previous experience of working in a natural environment, ecological knowledge, business skills, management experience, understanding of charities would all be useful skills to bring to the Trustee Board, but are not a pre-requisite.

We want to make sure that local people are heard, so our Trustee Board should ideally be made of people with a direct connection to the local area. Every trustee must have an interest in the needs and aspirations of the residents and visitors who use Hell Wath and a commitment to making a difference.

The Trustees meet a minimum of 4 time a year, with extra meetings when needed including some participation in Members Activity Group Meetings when needed and support of volunteer activity days.

The Charity Commission states that Trustees are responsible for controlling the management and administration of the charity. This includes setting and approving all policies and monitoring work methods, progress and expenditure to ensure that FOHW runs according to the terms of the grants which finance it and according to Charity Law.

Those elected will be required to sign the trustee Code of Conduct before their appoint is confirmed with the Charity Commission.
